Walk in the footsteps of Kupe Manea: Footprints of Kupe is a 75-minute multisensory journey of guided storytelling – through art, taonga (cultural treasures), film, performance, digital interaction and the splendour of Hokianga’s natural surroundings.

Whakapapa / Connect

Meet your guide and begin your journey in the footsteps of Kupe. Engage in stories about our ancestors and the ancient realms of Kupe, told through carvings and the surrounding land. Deepen your understanding of Māori customs and our dynamic connections to the natural and spiritual world.

Ruku / Immerse

On your arrival at the Manea whare taonga (house of treasures), our people welcome you with the timeless cultural ceremony of pōwhiri. You now enter the Manea theatre, where a 20-minute 4D-digital extravaganza and live performance immerses you in a full sensory recreation of the rich and vibrant world of the intrepid adventures of Kupe. You appreciate in a new way the extraordinary feats of our ancestors' ocean voyaging.

Toro / Interact

From the theatre, your guide will lead you outside to absorb the full significance of the Hokianga Harbour and our story. This was not only where Kupe made his home, but also his final departure point from this land. You can now continue your journey of discovery at your leisure in the Footprints of Kupe Interactive Gallery, where digital stations reveal more details of our ancestor's story.

Makue! Kai E! A twilight experience.

A warm whakatau ceremony marks entry into our Tawa forest village an evening celebrating our connection to our land,

forests and waterways and each other. Together we will prepare dinner - a special fried bread Puku Burger invented right here at Tamaki Māori Village!

Once inside our Tawa forest, bonfires blaze and delicious morsels are shared. Buttery corn cobs, boil up broth, mussels and smoked fish join seasonal delicacies like pikopiko –even huhu grubs when we can catch em! Enjoy a pre-dinner drink and soak in the buzz of Manawa o te Pā - the heart of the village. Seated for an alfresco dinner, your Puku Burger is served with fresh salad, produce, dressings and Māori herbs forged from local forests.

Kapahaka and impromptu “around the globe” performance kick start the entertainment, followed by a live musical soundscape for your alfresco feast. When dinner concludes, wander by lantern light for dessert in a secret forest alcove. Share in the magical firelight - before returning to Rotorua.

Makue! Kai E! is open every Saturday in February through March and every Friday and Saturday in April. Maximum Capacity is 20 pax and it is open on demand for group bookings during alert levels 1 & 2.

With a happy puku explore the beautiful forest of Tamaki Māori Village. Learn traditional pastime activities, feed the village tuna, identify the flora and fauna of the forest, unlock meanings of our carved houses – enjoy the serenity and warmth of our home.

This experience is interactive, educational and with a maximum 20 people, this small group tour offers a deeper connection with our people, history & culture.

Hui E! Kai E! is open every Sunday in February through March and Sunday and Monday during April.

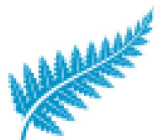
